Littlemore has been part of the Landscape of the Newman for quite some time. It has been a place for many students and peer ministers. Things have been changing over the last few years and Covid has not helped things in that the number of students requesting to live on/ or near campus. The house has not been full in over 4 years. In the meantime Leroy who put a lot of life into Littlemore has retired. His work was outstanding. That being said, the mantle to care for Littlemore in the way that Leroy did has not been passed on. There are as always maintenance issues that remain costly. It also is a questionable practice for a non profit to be in the business of renting. In checking none of the renters had agreed to leases after May 31.

So, in discussion with Nuts and Bolts, Finance, Tom Fischer, it has been decided to take the building down and have green space at least for the time being. The building has been used by the fire department for training, the asbestos has been removed free of charge in a generous donation. The building will come down and be moved away July 18th and then the hole will be filled with dirt which has also been donated in another generous donation.

Overall it seems to be the right time and the right decision. I want to thank all those who helped make Littlemore a great place for students and for those who did the work and donated to its removal. I also look forward to the possibilities of what can be done with the space.
