NEW WINE SKINS

This weekend we celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, God's way of pouring his new life and love into us. Jesus says, do not pour new wine into old wine skins, it'll only burst the old, and both the skins and wine will be destroyed. Pour new wine into new wine skins. Jesus encourages us to become new wine skins for the new wine. For God is ever constant and ever new. The Eucharist is the gift of new wine for our soul.

As I reflect on my time with you in the last 7 months, I know that I have changed. To be honest with you, it has taken a toll on me, but on the other hand, it has really expanded my spiritual life. During my time with you and accepting the challenge of Pastor and Chaplain, I prayed for God to help me expand my new wine skin. I truly believe God gives me all the grace and strength that I need. I also could not do this without your prayers and support, so thank you!

We as a Tri-Parish, are not like we were 50 years ago or 20 years ago or even 5 years ago. We have changed. Everybody has changed. Our culture has changed.
