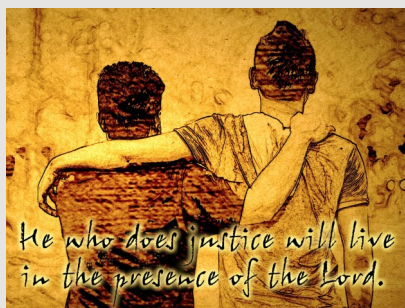

Trip to St Cloud France

Hi,

In celebration of the 1500 anniversary of the birth of Saint cloud, we have been invited by the church in Saint cloud France to join them in celebrating this event. Father Scott and father Joe are planning an ACC trip leaving Friday, October 28 returning Saturday, November 5. Approximate cost will be \$2600 for people over 30 and \$1500 for those under 31. This should cover most all of the expenses of this trip.

The parish in Saint cloud France is offering us host homes. This should make for a very interesting trip.

The current requirements are that you do not need to be vaxed but you may need to do a Covid test before departure if you are not vaxed.

You are free to make your own airline reservations if you want to go earlier or stay later or book with Miles. The cost is about 1300 for the flight and 1300 for the rest of the trip.

Please use the sign-up sheets in the back church and we are asking for a \$500 per person deposit. We will take up to 40 people.

Visit of the Miraculous Medal chapel, rue du Bac, Paris from 3 p.m.

River-boat cruise (from Pont de l'Alma to Notre Dame de Paris on the Seine river) at 6 p.m. with dinner on board
