

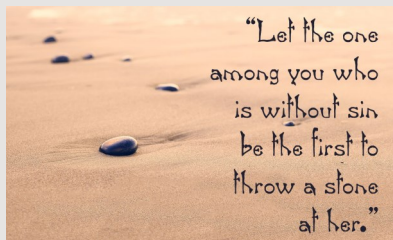

An ongoing refugee crisis began in Europe in late February 2022 after Russia's invasion of Ukraine. More than 4 million refugees have left Ukraine (as of 29 March 2022), an estimated 6.5 million people have been displaced within the country (as of 18 March 2022). In total, more than ten million people – almost a quarter of the population – had left their homes in Ukraine by 20 March. By March 24, 2022, according to UNICEF, more than half of all children in Ukraine had been forced to leave their homes. (Wikipedia)

El Salvador's congress granted President Nayib Bukele's request to declare a state of emergency early Sunday amid a wave of gang-related killings over the weekend. Fourteen people were killed Friday and 62 people died Saturday, a scale of violence that has not been seen for years. By comparison, there were 79 homicides in the entire month of February. (AP)

Chrism – used in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders, as well as for the consecration of altars and the dedication of churches

the oil of catechumens (formerly known as the oil of exorcism)– also used in the sacrament of Baptism, and

the Oil of the Sick – used only in the rite of the Anointing of the Sick
